

Foodbank Deputy Manager

Do some of the words above describe who you are? Do you have the passion and motivation to use your skills and experience to support the development of Foodbank outlets and their associated activities?

The Foodbank team, which supports church based outlets in the East and South of Bristol, have seen a significant increase in need. In 2019-20, nearly 6,000 people were supported through the outlets; that has exceeded 12,000 so far this year. Alongside our response to the Pandemic, the team continues to support long established outlets across East Bristol, is integrating a number of independent outlets across South Bristol and taking part in the Trussell Trust Pathfinder programme.



We need to recruit a Deputy Manager to replace a member of the team who is moving on. There will be a primary focus on supporting and developing the outlets across East Bristol as well as supporting work led by the Deputy Manager covering South Bristol.

Reporting to the South & East Bristol Foodbank Manager, you would be joining a small but busy staff team who often work remotely from one another but whom connect with a great team of outlet volunteers and voluntary team leaders. Personal drive and self-confidence will be key.

- *Hours: part-time 28 hours per week;*
 - *Work pattern to complement outlet opening times and current team;*
- *Workplace pension with matched contribution of up to 5%.*
